LAKE MAINTENANCE

Management and Aquatechnex are working closely together to address the cattails and algae bloom. The crew treated the lake with Clearcast to prohibit the cattails and floating aquatic plants in the upper ponds from growing back. They also treated the lake with SeClear to remove the algae. These processes are slow acting, so it may take up to three to four weeks to take effect.

LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE

As you may have noticed, there are some areas showing signs of stress due to the recent water restrictions. The Landscape Committee is working closely with Slade Landscape to develop a plan to restore these areas. Please be patient with the Committee and the landscaper during this process.
